TECHNICAL SPECIFICATION: Oatey Silicone Sealant is a one-part, mildew resistant sealant for ceramic tile, showers, tubs, rimless sinks and plumbing fixtures. Silicone Sealant is a 100% silicone sealant and has excellent resistance to weathering, including ozone, ultraviolet radiation and freeze-thaw conditions. Silicone Sealant remains flexible for years and won't sag or slump in joints.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Clean off any dirt or dust particles with water. Do not use soap. Using a utility knife, remove any remnants of old caulking. New caulk will not adhere well to previously cured caulk. Once all caulk residue is removed, clean the area with a mild abrasive or rubbing alcohol. Use a concentrated mildew remover if the area shows signs of mildew. With a 45° angle, cut the tapered nozzle of the caulk tube to the width required to fill the crack or joint. Hold the tube at a 45 angle and use even pressure to apply caulk. Move the tube at an even pace along the joint to be filled. If the bead of caulk is too narrow, re-cut the nozzle to provide a larger opening. Allow the caulk to set for sufficient time. Product should be protected from water for a minimum of 72 hours to allow initial curing. Silicone Sealant can be applied at temperatures between 0°F to 120° F and can withstand operating temperatures of -70 F to 400 F. Full clarity of sealant is reached in 7 days. Do not apply Silicone Sealant

PRECAUTIONS

Read all cautions and directions carefully before using this product. High vapor concentrations may cause headache, dizziness and nausea. Prolonged or repeated skin contact may lead to drying and irritation. Eye contact may cause irritation.

FIRST AID: If swallowed- Contact physician or poison control center immediately. Eye Contact- Flush eye with copious amounts of water while holding eyelid open.
